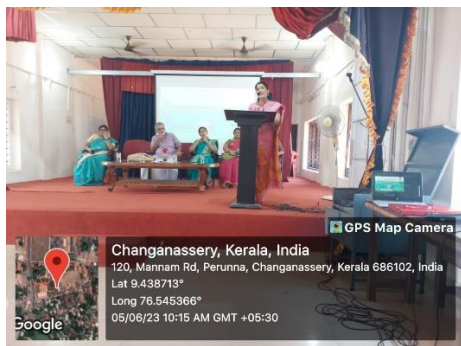
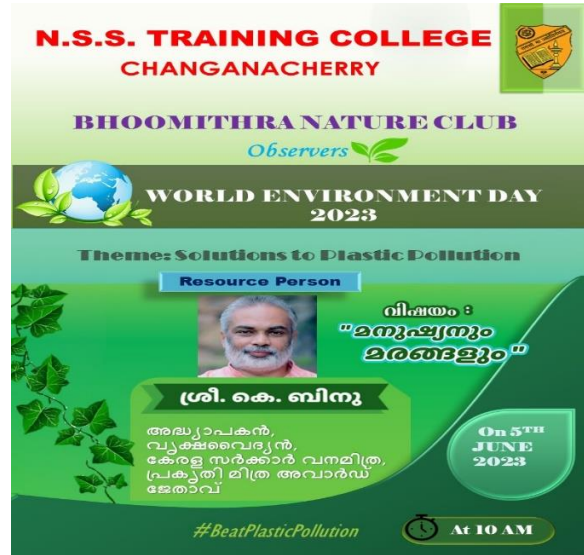


# OBSERVANCE OF WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2023

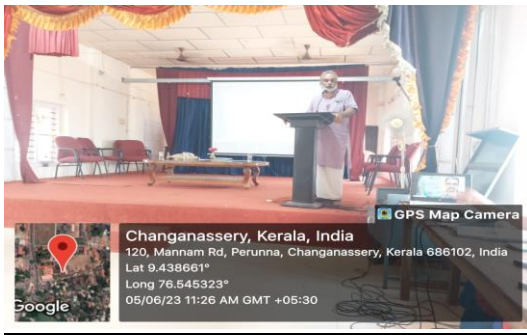
